**ORDER**

The Court has before it the Class Representative Plaintiffs' Amended Motion For Adoption of the Claim Administrator's Report ("Motion"), and the Defendants' oral motion, made this morning in open court, for authorization to transfer funds to United Missouri Bank account # 9871579344 ("Account"). The Court grants the Motion, and directs the Defendants to mail out, as soon as possible but no later than December 20, 2010, the notices and checks referenced in paragraphs five and six of the Motion. The Defendants shall provide notice to Class Counsel, via email and U.S. Mail, contemporaneous with its mailings, of the fact that it has commenced the process of making the mailings. The Defendants shall forthwith make the payment referenced in paragraph eight of the Motion. The Court also directs the Defendants that they may make the transfer requested in their oral motion, but the amount that they are allowed to transfer at this time is limited to the amount of funds necessary to make the payments referenced in this order ("Interim Payment Amount"); to the extent

that the interest-bearing account at St. Louis Bank has a balance in it that exceeds the Interim Payment Amount, that excess amount shall remain at St. Louis Bank in the interest-bearing account until ordered otherwise by this Court.
